Next, marvel at some of the city's most emblematic landmarks, including the soaring Jet d'Eau and the beautiful Flower Clock, symbols of Geneva's elegance and innovation. Depending on the season, continue with a charming mini-train ride or a guided walking tour to uncover the secrets of the Old Town's picturesque streets. Stroll through the banking district, admire the impressive St. Peter's Cathedral, wander across the lively Place du Bourg-de-Four, explore the historic Maison Tavel, and capture the Reformation Wall in Parc des Bastions before reaching the city's elegant shopping streets. To complete your experience, relax on a one-hour scenic boat cruise on Lake Geneva, offering stunning views of the city and surrounding landscapes.
