Itinerary	<p>Annecy – Morning</p> <p>Palais de l'Île – Annecy's most iconic landmark, built on the Thiou River and formerly a medieval prison. Saint-François de Sales Church – A charming Baroque church connected to the Order of the Visitation. Rue Sainte-Claire – A historic street lined with traditional arcades and artisan boutiques. Annecy Castle (exterior) – The former residence of the Counts of Geneva, overlooking the town. Old Town & Canals – Explore the medieval center, the Thiou River, and Annecy's colorful houses.</p> <p>Free Time</p> <p>After the guided visit, enjoy free time to browse the local markets, visit a museum, have lunch, or stroll along the lakeshore.</p> <p>Geneva – Afternoon</p> <p>Palais des Nations (UN) – Drive past the United Nations headquarters with a 5-minute photo stop. Broken Chair – A monumental sculpture symbolizing the fight against landmines. World Health Organization (WHO) – Overview of the role of this major global health institution. International Labour Organization (ILO) – UN agency dedicated to labor rights and social justice. World Trade Organization (WTO) – Headquarters of global trade governance. World Meteorological Organization (WMO) – International center for climate and weather coordination. International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) – Founded in Geneva, a key actor in humanitarian action.</p> <p>City Tour – Geneva Centre & Lakeside</p> <p>Jet d'Eau – Geneva's most famous symbol, rising high above the lake. Flower Clock – A floral tribute to Swiss watchmaking. Lakeside Parks and Quays – Beautiful views of the Alps and Geneva's elegant waterfront atmosphere.</p> <p>Old Town – Mini-Train or Walking Tour (depending on the season)</p> <p>St. Peter's Cathedral – The heart of the Protestant Reformation. Maison Tavel – Geneva's oldest house, now a museum. Place du Bourg-de-Four – The city's oldest and most charming square. Reformation Wall – An emblematic monument located in Parc des Bastions. Banking District – Elegant architecture characteristic of Geneva's financial institutions. Shopping Streets – Explore the lively and refined commercial area of the Old Town. Cruise on lake Geneva</p>

Information point	Departure is from Geneva Bus Station (Place Dorcière, 1201 Geneva) near the main train station, Gare Cornavin.
