Glacier 3000 is a snowy wonderland for outdoor and adventure enthusiasts, with a wide variety of activities available. This snowy paradise is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts and adventure seekers, offering a wide range of activities. Reach the glacier's summit with a thrilling 15-minute cable car ride that delivers panoramic views of the surrounding peaks.</p> <p>In the summer, the glacier is home to the Alpine Coaster, Europe's highest toboggan run, providing an exciting ride for thrill-seekers. Another highlight is the Peak Walk available all year, the world's first suspension bridge connecting two mountain peaks. The 108-meter-long bridge is accessible year-round, and walking across it offers breathtaking views of over 24 peaks towering above 4,000 meters.</p> <p>Whether you're enjoying the stunning fun park or the mesmerizing chair lifts, the Glacier 3000 area offers endless opportunities to connect with nature, making memories that will last a lifetime.</p> <p>Next, head to Montreux, a town famous for its exceptional climate, often referred to as the "capital of the Vaud Riviera." The area's mild weather allows Mediterranean plants like pines, cypresses, and palm trees to thrive. Montreux is also known for its rich cultural history, with famous residents such as Charlie Chaplin and Freddie Mercury, and continues to attract artists and celebrities from around the world.</p> <p>Take some free time to explore this elegant town, stroll along its lakeside promenade, and discover the blend of natural beauty and artistic heritage that makes Montreux one of Switzerland's most iconic destinations.</p>
